

Suffolk (VA) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated Scholarship Criteria and Guidelines

Criteria

- 1. The applicant must meet the focus of The Links, Incorporated mission and be African American or other people of African ancestry.
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating senior from a public high school in Suffolk, Isle of Wight, Southampton, Franklin or Surry County.
- 3. The applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. The applicant must be a student who plans to pursue a college degree.
- 5. The applicant must demonstrate or document financial need.

Guidelines for Submission

- 1. The applicant must submit an official high school transcript.
- 2. The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from a high school principal, counselor, teacher, sponsor, minister, or other community leaders. No relative of an applicant may submit a letter of recommendation.
- 3. Completed application and other requested documentation/information must be postmarked **by March 28th**, and mailed, or may be hand-delivered, to the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee:

- 4. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications; consider recommendations; and make final selection(s), solely under the auspices of Suffolk (VA) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated.
- 5. The scholarship will be given to the awardee, after the committee has received verification from the college or university registrar's office, validating that the student/awardee is enrolled as a full-time student.
