

## Hattie P. West Community Service Award

## **Application Criteria and Award Guidelines**

## Criteria

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior from a public school in Suffolk, Virginia.
- **2.** The applicant must be a student who plans to pursue a college degree, within one year.
- 3. The applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. The applicant must demonstrate or document financial needs.
- 5. The applicant must demonstrate leadership and community service.
- **6.** The applicant must attend an HBCU.

## Guidelines for Submission, Selection, and Award

- 1. The applicant must submit an official high school transcript.
- 2. The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from a high school principal, counselor, teacher, sponsor, minister, or other community leaders. No relative of the applicant may submit a letter of recommendation.
- **3.** Completed application and other required documentation/information must be postmarked by **March 28th**, and mailed, or hand-delivered, to the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee:

- 4. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications; consider recommendations and make final selection(s), solely under the auspices of Suffolk (VA) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated.
- 5. The award will be given to the awardee, after the committee has received verification from the college or university registrar's office, validating that the student/awardee is enrolled as a full-time student.
